Plans for renovation

The Neighbours Hall has provided and continues to provide a valuable asset to the people of Great Milton. It is planned to update the fabric so that we can improve its usefulness and its energy efficiency. Some of these changes are those planned for but not executed in 2005.

We have already had the carpark regraded and relaid through the generosity of Greenplant.

Other changes proposed include:

- an outside recreational area: for children and adults
- enlarging the entrance lobby and resiting the main entrance
- rebuilding and resiting the lavatories
- resiting the maintenance cupboard
- opening up the rear room
- making access doors to the recreational area from the entrance lobby and the rear room
- keeping the stage and incorporating access from both sides
- removing the suspended ceiling
- insulating the whole building, the roof internally and the side walls with insulated rendering
- treating the floor
- using the old lobby as a store, whilst retaining access to the hall
